# North Tawton Afternoon W.I.

Dictionary definition of 'to gloat'. To dwell on one's own success or another's misfortune with smugness or malignant pleasure. Doesn't sound very nice does it? Wouldn't think a member of North Tawton W.I. could behave in such a manner would you? Well – think again. There is a gloater in our midst. And it's me. I couldn't help myself. I came over all 'gloatee' (that's not a real word) and it felt SO good. I blame the Sampford Courtenay & Honeychurch Flower, Produce and Craft Show. They made me do it. One of the classes is the exotically titled 'Spud in a Bucket' class. It is simply brilliant. You collect a bucket and a single seed spud early in the year from Bill and Marion (the hard-working and dedicated organisers) - you mix up your own growing medium/compost in the bucket, you pop your seed spud in the compost and that's it. Feed it/water it/ earth it up. Take it along to the Show where the buckets will be emptied one at a time and your crop will be weighed. And that's where reputations can be savagely ripped apart. Husband and I thought we'd have a go. So we did. His spud bucket was upended and we all held our breath. His expectations were high. The compost was pulled apart. To reveal (in my opinion) a feeble and meagre crop. Tensions were rising as my bucket edged ever nearer to the 'big reveal'. I could barely watch. My bucket was heaved up on to the truck and upended. YES YES!!!!!! Husband's expression was one of total disbelief. And my moment of gloating began. I couldn't help myself. My little seed spud had produced twice the amount of spuds as his. He's not taken it too well. He's sat in his shed.

Sulking.

Our September speaker, Mick Harrison, is a retired policeman and is now working with the Devon and Cornwall Police as a Cyber Protection Officer. Every Police Force now receives funding from the Home Office in order to pay for Cyber Protection Officers due to the huge increase in phishing emails, bogus websites and telephone scams. Mick talks to businesses, charities and community groups raising awareness and promoting preventative measures that are available to help protect them from becoming victims of cyber crime. Mick advises to always be sceptical – never assume, never believe and always confirm before you respond to incoming messages. 'If it's out of the blue – it's not for you' – and if you're not expecting it, dump it. Ensure you create strong passwords – he suggests using three random words, make sure they have at least 12 characters and consider including a £ sign which can make your password more difficult to hack. 2 step verification or 2 factor authentication is particularly vital to secure important accounts such as your bank account and your primary email account.

Always install the latest software and app updates and only install official apps, i.e. Windows, Google Play and Apple. Make sure your antivirus and firewalls are always on and regularly back up your most important data. Mick encouraged us to pay by credit card when online – you have better protection that way. Check for bogus emails by hovering your mouse over an email address or website, be sceptical of phone calls that you aren't expecting – check your own records for the proper number and phone them back. Dialling 159 will connect you to your banks fraud department, which is a secure way to verify suspicious financial calls. Finally (and scarily) AI scammers only need to record three seconds of your voice to make a copy. Wonder if a strong Devon accent would make them think twice?

Recent events and W.I. happenings have included an antiques evening, with the marvellously entertaining Charles Hanson, — and a garden visit to the picturesque Whiddon Goyle which was a real treat — it was a very hot afternoon but our ladies still managed to stay cool and float around the garden in a very floaty fashion knowing that lurking in the shade was tea and delicious home-made cake. Other events in our W.I. diary this year include a visit to North Tawton's very own blacksmith, our annual Quiz, a shopping trip to Clarks village and a silk scarf printing workshop. Oh — and skittles. Lots of skittles. Well, that all depends if we get past the first knockout round. Cos last year we didn't.

Husband says he's bored of sulking. So he's off to do some 'diggin' up and drawin' back' which is code for 'a bit o' shovellin'/movin' the soil around a bit'. It's like therapy. Only it's a lot cheaper. And you get spuds.


# BONDLEIGH RAINFALL

# Introducing the new GP Partner for Bow and North Tawton Medical Practice, Dr. Jack Hodge.

# He writes:

I grew up mainly in Sussex but also before that in Cardiff, North Wales and for 5 years in North Germany as my father worked for the MOD.

Following training as a medical student and (junior resident) doctor in Birmingham, I moved to Barnstaple to take up a training position in Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the North Devon District Hospital. It was here I met my now wife who was completing teacher training at a local school. Following completion of that year, I transferred down to Derriford Hospital, Plymouth where I completed training in A&E and Trauma Surgery. I continued working in emergency medicine and intensive care in New Zealand and Australia, including an 18 month stint as a flying doctor covering most of New Zealand's South Island. My local claim to fame is when playing for Barnstaple RFC, my place in the back row was taken by an All Black who happened to be the area as I was on call that weekend! I also enjoy winter sports.

My clinical interests are acute illness management and keeping patients out of hospital. I believe that, using technology and training, a lot of the services provided by resident doctors in a distant hospital setting can be provided by a GP locally.







# **News from North Tawton Community Primary School and Nursery**



The children are now well settled into their classes and the new school year and there is a happy buzz of learning around the school.

- In Nursery and Reception our youngest children have been busy exploring their new surroundings. In Acorns and Oaks learning space you'll find dinosaurs, castles, princesses and dragons paint, crayons, playdough, sand, water and mud books, and music farms, kitchens, shops... the whole world in their small world! Our skilled teachers let the children lead the way, interacting with them to develop the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Areas of Learning. While they play the children are being guided in communication and language, personal, social and emotional development and physical development. As part of this, we are working with the children to develop a set of school values that will guide how we behave, treat others, and learn together. The children are exploring what values are and why they are important. They will work together in small groups to discuss different values such as kindness, respect, and resilience. Finally, they will agree on the values they feel are most important for our school community. Next month we will be ready to share those values with the wider community.

New to the school myself, I have been bowled over by the wonderful team I find myself in. Every member of staff puts the children first and works incredibly hard to ensure that they have the best possible experience at school. This is a very special school in a truly beautiful setting.






